Shaun Adams seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

The Finance Director presented the October 31, 2021 Budget vs Actual Report to the Board.

Employee cost of living increase and Christmas pay:

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the 3% employee cost of living increase retroactive to July 1, 2021 and the employee \$550 Christmas pay for all employees, to be paid the week of Thanksgiving. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Library and Senior Center Support:

Brian Johnson made a motion to approve the \$7,000 Library support and \$3,000 Senior Center support. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Election workers – Hazard pay:

Debbie Beasley made a motion to approve the additional leak credit request for 2742 Tallulah Road for \$239.44. Shaun Adams seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Maintenance Supervisor Assistant:

Shaun Adams made a motion to table until a job description is presented to the Board. Brian Johnson seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

RHS Yearbook advertisement:
