Mayor Update:

Mayor Hooper updated the Board on a couple of maintenance issues.

2021 Election location:

Shaun Adams made a motion to hold the 2021 Municipal Election at 196 Knight Street for the November 2, 2021 election. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Powell Fund – Budget Amendment:

The Finance Director said that the Town's Auditor questioned if Bud Carpenter's salary is allowed as a Powell Fund expenditure. The Finance Director researched the question and found that Bud Carpenter's salary to pick up regular trash is not allowed under Powell Fund expenditures. Budget Amendment #1, \$11,300 will reclass Bud Carpenter's salary expense to the General Fund Streets which is funded by the

taxes from the local taxpayers. Brian Johnson made a motion to approve Budget Amendment #1. Debbie Beasley seconded the motion. Vote unanimous.

Closed Session:
